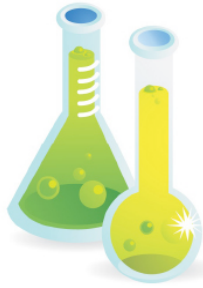

## What does 4-H require?

- Teachers are asked to conduct at least six hours of instruction from the lessons provided.
- Teachers are asked to fill out an evaluation.
- Teachers will be asked to provide general information on their participants (gender, race, grade).
